Match Rules and Equipment

200 Yard Military Rifle Match (One Relay)

- Sighters 5 Rounds in 10 Minutes
- First Stage Prone Slow Fire 10 Rounds in 10 Minutes
- Second Stage Prone Rapid Fire 10 Rounds in 80 Seconds
- Third Stage Offhand Slow Fire 10 Rounds in 10 Minutes

This is a "fun match" and will closely follow, but not be restricted to, rules for CMP high power matches. Any service grade rifle, service grade sights or scope, 1 1/4" leather or web slings. Ammunition for 30 shots (plus sighters). Additional equipment may include shooting mat, glove, shooting jacket, and spotting scope. Official NRA SR targets and SR target centers will be provided. All shooters are asked to bring staplers, staples, and pasters as needed to repair targets.

Shooters Must Provide Eye and Ear Protection and Ammo Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI's) Are Mandatory

Rimfire Sporter Matches

Standard .22 LR caliber rimfire sporter type rifles not exceeding 7.5 lbs (including optics). Trigger weight of not less than 3 pounds. Telescopic or open sights may be used. Telescopic sights are limited to maximum 6X power. Leather or web slings, not wider than $1\frac{1}{4}$ ", may be used in prone and sitting (or kneeling) positions.

Additional equipment may include shooting mat (recommended), work-style glove for support hand, and spotting scopes. No thumbhole stocks, bananna magazines, cheek pieces, adjustable butt plates, rails, or adjustable sling swivels are allowed. You may use only .22 LR ammo, absolutely no magnum rounds are allowed. Official CMP targets and repair centers will be provided. All shooters are asked to bring staplers, staples, and pasters as needed to repair targets.

Shooters Must Provide Eye and Ear Protection and 60 Rounds of Ammo (Plus Sighters) Per Relay

Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI's) Are Mandatory

- Sighting Stage Unlimited Shots, prone position, 10 minute time limit
- Stage 1: Prone Position, Slow Fire, 10 Shots, 10 Minute Time Limit, 50 Yards
- Stage 2: From a Standing to Prone Position, 10 Shots, Two Strings, 5 Shots Per String, Rapid Fire 50 Yards
- Stage 3: Sitting or Kneeling Position, Slow Fire, 10 Shots, 10 Minute Time Limit, 50 Yards
- Stage 4: Standing to Sitting or Kneeling Position, 10 Shots, Two Strings, 5 Shots Per String, Rapid Fire 50 Yards
- Stage 5: Standing Position, Slow Fire, 10 Shots, 10 Minute Time Limit, 25 Yards
- Stage 6: Standing Position (Starting with butt of rifle on hip), 10 Shots, Two Strings, 5 Shots Per String, Rapid Fire 25 Yards

Semi-automatic rifles are allowed 25 seconds for rapid fire strings

Bolt action, manually operated rifles, are allowed 30 seconds for rapid fire strings
